Different from the 'traditional' education system where students learn at school, acquire new knowledge and skills, and eventually having to sit for exams and put down all the knowledge and skills acquired in exams and graded by how much they have been able to recite, at UJUZI we insist on applying the skills learned in everyday life for social impact.

With our method of skills development, we hope to contribute to shaping how Tanzanian youth learn via out of school curricula trainings, hackathons and events where young girls and boys not only learn and gain new skills but also apply skills gained in a problem-solving real-life case or scenario.

Our motto is that learning should be done with the aim of having a social impact by applying the skills learned; hence, during our trainings, we emphasize on learning by doing with problem-solving skills; introduction of problems; and solving these problems either as an individual or as a team. Through this process, youth build their self confidence, learn public speaking and learn to work in a team.

PUM is a Dutch organisation established to help SMEs grow in developing countries and emerging markets and create a positive impact on the

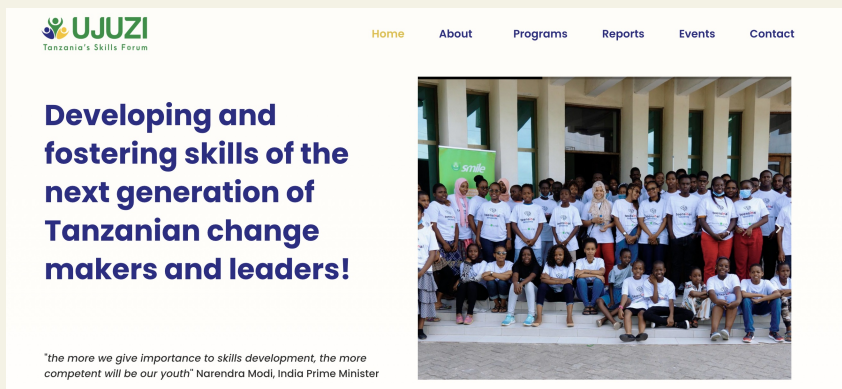
economy, environment and society.
